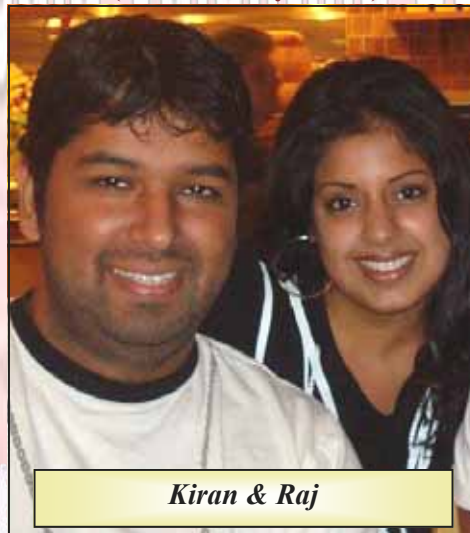
Rituals are the glue that bond relationships together. You probably already have rituals in your relationship (the good-bye kiss, the daily phone call from work) but may not realize how important
